**TEXT ORDER** granting in part [270] Motion to delay reporting date and location recommendation as to Michael G Cale (1). The Defendant has filed a motion requesting to delay his report date to the U.S. Bureau of Prisons (BOP) until on or after [Redacted] to obtain medical treatment and that the court recommend to the BOP that the Defendant be allowed to serve his sentence at the Federal Correctional Center in Edgefield, South Carolina. (ECF No. [Redacted]). The motion states that the Government takes no position on these requests. The court declines to issue an amended judgment order but finds that a supplemental order to address the Defendant's requests is appropriate. Accordingly, the Motion ([Redacted]) is **GRANTED, IN PART**, such that the Defendant's report date is extended until [Redacted] or such time thereafter as determined by the BOP. Additionally, for the reasons stated in the motion, it is requested that the BOP allow the Defendant to serve his sentence at FCI Edgefield, South Carolina.
